The Safest Way to Prevent Your Car Battery from Draining

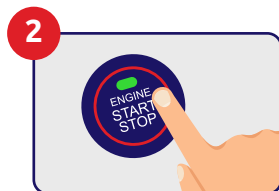
One common concern among vehicle owners is a drained battery when the car is rarely used. The safest way to prevent this is to disconnect the battery's negative cable.

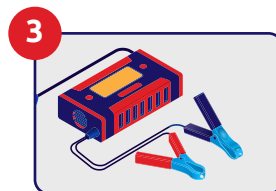
In addition to disconnecting the negative battery cable, here are a few other important tips to keep your battery in good condition and prevent it from draining easily:
